5. The parties have executed a Stipulation and Settlement Agreement resolving all issues in this matter. The Court finds the agreement to be fair and equitable. The Stipulation is incorporated herein by reference as though fully set forth and is filed under seal. The parties are ordered to comply with its terms.
6. The parties are hereby bound by the terms and provisions of the Stipulation and Settlement Agreement and such terms and upon the entry of this Decree of Divorce, such terms and provisions are hereby enforceable against the parties.
7. Based upon the parties' Stipulation, the Court has entered Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law which form the basis for the entry of a Decree of Divorce.

8. The Parties should be duly ordered to execute and deliver all documents necessary to effectuate the Decree of Divorce.

DISSOLUTION OF THE MARRIAGE

9. With the entry of this Decree of Divorce, the marriage between the parties is hereby dissolved.
