FOLLOWS:

1. That the Plaintiff be awarded judgment against the Defendant for the sum of \$2214.21 which is inclusive of \$1321.00 in principal, \$330.25 in collection fees, \$72.96 in interest, \$140.00 in court cost and \$350.00 in attorney's fees; as prayed for in the complaint.
2. That interest on the total at the rate of 18% per annum pursuant to Section 15-1-4 U.C.A. from the date of this judgment until paid.
3. The Defendant is to pay \$75.00 per month commencing July 15, 2026, and each month thereafter until paid in full.
4. The Plaintiff agree to forego executing on post judgment remedies as long as the defendant makes the payments when due.
