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Plaintiff's Motion for Renewal of Judgment as to Defendant Elenoa Vakapuna was filed with the Court on June 29, 2026. Plaintiff's motion included the supporting Declaration of Richard C. Terry. No responsive pleading has been filed by the Defendant. Having considered the fully-briefed motion, the Court hereby finds that the facts in the support affidavit are accurate and that notice has been property given.

NOW THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED, as follows:

1. Plaintiff's Motion for Renewal of Judgment is granted.

2. Plaintiff's judgment as to Defendant Elenoa Vakapuna dated July 16, 2018, is renewed for an additional eight years from the entry of this order or from the scheduled expiration date of the original order, whichever occurs first.

3. The amount now due and owing is as follows:

753.50	Post-judgment attorney fees,

with interest accruing on the Total Judgment from June 29, 2026, at the contract rate of 12% until paid in full.

4. The judgment creditor is Jordan Credit Union. The judgment debtor is Elenoa Vakapuna. There are no assignors or assignees as this judgment has not been assigned.

5. The judgment rendered on June 30, 2010, and renewed on July 16, 2018, which is hereby renewed, was recorded on July 30, 2018, with the Davis County Recorder's Office as Entry No. 3107882, Book 7066, Pages 1350-1354, creating a lien on the Defendant's real property in favor of Plaintiff.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that this renewed judgment may be augmented in the amount of reasonable costs and attorney's fees expended in collecting this renewed judgment pursuant to Rule 73, Utah Rules of Civil Procedure.
