Based upon the Affidavit of David M. McGrath Regarding Default Under Stipulation and Motion for Entry of Judgment Against One Defendant Pursuant to Rule 54(b) filed in this action which sets forth the default of Defendant Max International, Inc. under the Stipulation Regarding Payment of the Subject Obligation dated June 16, 2025, and good cause appearing therefore,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED, ADJUDGED, AND DECREED that no just reason exists to delay the entry of judgment against Defendant Max International, Inc. only and that judgment is hereby entered against Defendant Max International, Inc. as follows:

(i) For the principal amount of \$83,145.80, plus accrued interest in the amount of \$4,341.23 through July 16, 2026, plus accruing interest on the principal amount at the rate of Plaintiff's prime rate plus 9.00% per annum, both before and after judgment, from July 17, 2026 until paid in full.

(ii) For Plaintiff's costs and disbursements incurred in this action in the amount of \$51.49, together with attorney's fees in the amount of \$475.00.

The total judgment amount in this action is \$88,013.52.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the judgment entered as described above may be augmented (i) in the amount of reasonable costs incurred by Plaintiff in collecting said judgment, and (ii) in the amount of attorney's fees as allowed by Rule 73, Utah Rules of Civil Procedure.
