In accordance with Utah Rule of Civil Procedure 78B-6-1802, and in response to plaintiff's MOTION TO RENEW JUDGMENT, judgment renewal in favor of the plaintiff is hereby granted. The original Default Judgment was entered on July 30, 2018, in the total amount of \$7,022.67, which consisted of \$5,258.45 in principal, \$769.22 in interest, \$775.00 in attorney fees, and \$220.00 in costs.
