The court decrees:

Divorce

1. jason ray thorsted is granted a divorce based on the Declaration of Jurisdiction and Grounds signed by jason ray thorsted. The divorce will become final upon entry of the divorce decree.

Children (Utah Code 81-6-101(7))

2. **jason ray thorsted** and **anna marie evangelista** do not have any children together.

- We do not have any children together who are minors. A minor is a child under 18 who has not been married or otherwise emancipated.
- We are not expecting a child.
- We do not have incapacitated adult children together who are eligible for child support, or, **jason ray thorsted** is not asking for child support for any adult child who is eligible for child support.

6. Neither party will pay alimony.

Retirement money

7. The parties do not need a court order about retirement money.

Duty to sign documents

8. The parties will sign all documents necessary to comply with the divorce decree within 60 days from entry of the decree. If a party fails to sign a document within 60 days, the other party may ask the court to appoint someone to sign the document. (Utah Rule of Civil Procedure 70)
