In accordance with Utah Code 81-9-208, the above-captioned matter came before the court for consideration absent a hearing. Pursuant to the Stipulation, a judgment can be entered.

The court, having reviewed the pleadings on file herein, and having entered

its Findings of Fact

and Conclusions of Law, does now ORDER, ADJUDGE, and DECREE as follows:

Divorce

1. Patricia Hancock is granted a divorce based on the Declaration of Jurisdiction and Grounds signed by Patricia Hancock. The divorce will become final upon entry of the divorce decree.

Children (Utah Code 81-6-101(7))

2. **Patricia Hancock** and **John Richard Pearce** do not have any children together.
 - We do not have any children together who are minors. A minor is a child under 18 who has not been married or otherwise emancipated.
 - We are not expecting a child.
 - We do not have incapacitated adult children together who are eligible for child support, or, **Patricia Hancock** is not asking for child support for any adult child who is eligible for child support.

Personal property (Utah Code Title 81, Chapters 1, 4, 6, and 9)

3. All personal property not addressed in the divorce should be divided as the parties have already divided it.
4. This other property will be divided as follows:

The parties signed and executed a prenuptial agreement on June 4, 2021. These documents are consistent with the parties' signed agreement.

Debts

5. The parties are not aware of any debts from the marriage. If any debts exist, each debt will be the responsibility of the party who incurred the debt.

Real property

6. The parties do not have any real property that is marital property.

The parties do not need a court order about real property.

Alimony

7. Neither party will pay alimony.

Retirement money

8. The parties do not need a court order about retirement money.

Duty to sign documents

9. The parties will sign all documents necessary to comply with the divorce decree within 60 days from entry of the decree. If a party fails to

sign a document within 60 days, the other party may ask the court to appoint someone to sign the document. (Utah Rule of Civil Procedure 70)
