CHARGES

1. ASSAULT W/ SUBSTANCIAL BODILY INJURY (amended) - Class A  
Misdemeanor

HEARING

Defendant present in custody from the Weber County Jail.

SENTENCE JAIL

Based on the defendant's conviction of ASSAULT W/ SUBSTANCIAL BODILY INJURY a Class A Misdemeanor, the defendant is sentenced to a term of 1 year(s) The total time suspended for this charge is 1 year(s).

Credit is granted for 43 day(s) previously served.



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#### ORDER OF PROBATION

The defendant is placed on probation for 36 month(s).  
Probation is to be supervised by Adult Probation and Parole.  
Defendant to serve 180 day(s) jail.

Defendant is to pay a fine of 0

#### PROBATION CONDITIONS

The defendant shall enter into an agreement with the Utah State Department of Adult Probation & Parole and comply strictly with its terms and conditions.

The defendant shall report to the Department of Corrections and to the court whenever required.

The defendant shall violate no law, either federal, state or municipal.

The defendant shall serve 6 months in the Weber County Jail with credit for time served of 43 days. Defendant is not entitled to statutory good time.

The defendant shall successfully complete a mental health evaluation and treatment as determined appropriate, paying all costs.

The defendant shall successfully complete a substance abuse evaluation and treatment as determined appropriate, paying all costs.

The defendant shall pay total restitution in the amount of \$1,644.52 as follows:

- ... a) \$1,122.52 to McKay Dee Hospital;
- ... b) \$282.00 to Wasatch Radiology; and
- ... c) \$240.00 to Wasatch Emergency.

The defendant shall reimburse Weber County the sum of \$500.00 for public defender services rendered.

The defendant shall consume no alcohol or drugs nor frequent any location where alcohol or drugs are being used nor associate with anyone who is using alcohol or drugs.

The defendant shall submit to search, seizure and chemical testing without a warrant, paying all costs.

The defendant shall have no contact, directly or indirectly, with Heather Hamblin, Darrell Fields or Dan Corsi.

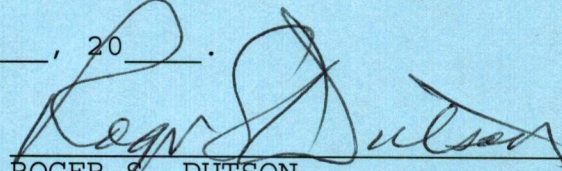


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The defendant shall maintain full-time employment.
