7. It is in the children's best interest that the parties be awarded Joint Legal and Joint Physical Custody. **Evan Dean Colver** is filing this Parenting Plan and verifies the plan is filed in good faith.

8. The children should reside in **Evan Dean Colver's** home **183** overnights each year and in **Hailea Ann Nalani Colver's** home **182** overnights each year.

## Parent-time

9. Parent-time will be equal between the parties. (Utah Code 81-9-305 and 81-6-206(7))

## Parent-time transfers

12. Pick-up and drop-off ("transfers") of the children for parent-time will be as described below:

The parties will make arrangements for pick up, delivery and return of the children prior to each scheduled parent-time.

## Curbside transfers

13. There will not be curbside transfers. The parent/person dropping-off or picking-up a child may accompany the children to the other parent/person when parent-time transfers are made.

### Decision-making

14. Each parent will make day-to-day decisions for the children during the time they are caring for the children. Either parent may make emergency decisions affecting the health or safety of the children. A parent who makes an emergency decision must share the decision with the other parent as soon as reasonably possible.

**Joint decision-making.** The parents will share responsibility for making major decisions about the children. If there is a disagreement, the parents will resolve the dispute as provided in the Resolving disputes section below.

### Education plan

15. The school the children will attend is based on **Evan Dean Colver's** home residence.

16. Evan Dean Colver and Hailea Ann Nalani Colver has authority to check the children out of school. Evan Dean Colver and Hailea Ann Nalani Colver has access to the children during school. If the parents cannot agree, education decisions will be made by Hailea Ann Nalani Colver.

### Communication with each other

17. Parents will communicate with each other by any method.

### Communication with the children

18. The parents agree they will:

- provide age-appropriate help to the children to communicate with the other parent.
- give the children privacy during their communication with the other parent. The parents will not interfere with or monitor communication between the children and the other parent.

19. Parents and children may communicate with each other whenever the children choose.

- By any method

### Records and information sharing

20. Both parents will have access to records and the ability to consult with providers regarding education, child care, and health care.

### Travel by the children

21. During their parent-time, the parent may consent for the children to travel with a sports team, religious group, school group, relatives, friends, by themselves, or with

others.

22. If the children will be travelling for more than **3** days, the parent arranging the travel will notify the other parent at least **7** days in advance. That parent will give the other parent the travel schedule, locations and phone numbers at least **5** days in advance. In case of emergency, the parent will provide as much notice as possible.

### Child care

23. A child care provider for our children must be:

A licensed child care provider.

A relative, friend, or neighbor.

Other qualifications: **Any child care provider used for the minor children shall be someone both parties reasonably approve of and trust to provide safe and appropriate care.**

### Relocation of a parent

24. Neither parent may relocate with the minor children more than **100** miles from their current residence without a written agreement signed by the parties or further court order.

25. If either parent lives more than 149 miles away from the other or the parents live in separate countries, costs for the children's travel expenses for parent-time will be paid by **the the parent who moved.**

26. If a parent has been found in contempt for not being current on all support obligations, and they do not have primary physical care of the child, they will be responsible for the child's related travel expenses.

27. Reimbursement for the child's travel expenses must be made within 30 days of receipt of documents detailing those expenses.

### Resolving disputes

28. If the parents need to resolve a dispute regarding the children, they will discuss the issues in good faith and try to reach an agreement based on what is best for their children. If the parents are unable to agree, they will go to the following before bringing the issue to the court:

a. **Mediation**

### Changing the plan

This plan remains in effect until changed. A change comes from a modification of a court order.

### Military Parenting Plan (Utah Code Title 81, Chapter 10, Part 4)

This Military Parenting Plan is proposed by the **petitioner**.

29. This Military Parenting Plan is in addition to the standard Parenting Plan because **Petitioner** is a servicemember.

#### Military Parenting Plan: Notice of deployment

30. After receiving notice of deployment, a deploying parent will give written notice to the other parent within 7 days or as soon as reasonably possible. If the non-deploying parent has a protective order against the deploying parent, the deploying parent will give written notice of deployment to the court. The written notice of deployment should include the destination, duration, and conditions.

#### Military Parenting Plan: Caretaking authority during deployment

31. Only **Petitioner** is a servicemember. While **Petitioner** is deployed, caretaking authority of the parties' children is given to:

- **Hailea Ann Nalani Colver**, who is not deployed.
- **Evan Dean Colver** will keep some caretaking authority.

32. A person granted caretaking authority must notify the following people of any change in mailing or residential address:

- The deploying parent,
- Anyone with physical or legal custody,
- Anyone who has parent-time, right to access, visitation, and
- Anyone with authority to grant limited contact with the children.

33. However, if a person granted caretaking authority has a court order protecting their address, they must give written notice of any change in mailing or residential address to the court.

#### Military Parenting Plan: Decision-making authority during deployment

34. The people given caretaking authority above will have decision-making authority to:

- Make day-to-day decisions for the children during the time they are caring for the children.
- Make emergency decisions affecting the health or safety of the children. A parent who makes an emergency decision must share the decisions with the other people who have caretaking authority as soon as reasonably possible.

#### Military Parenting Plan: Resolving disputes

35. If the people given caretaking authority need to resolve a dispute about the children, they will discuss the issues in good faith and try to reach an agreement based on what is best for the children.

36. If the people given caretaking authority are unable to agree, they will participate in the following before bringing the issue to the court:

- a. Mediation, Arbitration, Counseling

#### Military Parenting Plan: Contact with the deployed parent

37. There will be contact with the children and the deployed parent. **Hailea Ann Nalani Colver** will arrange for the contact. Contact will be as follows:



Frequency: Weekly

Duration: 1 hour

Method: Video call

Military Parenting Plan: Contact when deployed parent is on leave or is otherwise available

38. When the deployed parent is on leave or is otherwise available, contact with the children will be as follows:

**b. When the deployed parent is on leave or otherwise available, contact with the children shall occur as reasonably agreed upon and supported by both parties, taking into consideration the children's schedules and best interests.**

Military Parenting Plan: Child support not modified

39. Child support obligations cannot be modified by the Military Parenting Plan.

40. Changing child support requires a court order.

41. The arrangements in this Military Parenting Plan terminate immediately upon return.

42. A joint physical custody arrangement may result in denial of cash assistance under the Employment Support Act, Title 35A, Chapter 3, of the Utah Code.

## END OF PARENTING PLAN

Income: Petitioner (Evan Dean Colver) (Utah Code 81-6-203)

43. **Evan Dean Colver's** gross monthly income for child support purposes is **\$10000**.

**Evan Dean Colver** receives the following gross monthly income:

a. **Evan Dean Colver** is employed at **Utah Army National Guard** and grosses **\$7708.33** per month. **Evan Dean Colver** is voluntarily underemployed and is capable of working at a job which pays more. Based upon **Evan Dean Colver's** work experience, gross monthly income should be attributed to **Evan Dean Colver** in the amount of **\$10000** per month. (Utah Code 81-6-203)

Income: Respondent (Hailea Ann Nalani Colver) (Utah Code 81-6-203)

44. **Hailea Ann Nalani Colver's** gross monthly income for child support purposes is **\$7500**. **Hailea Ann Nalani Colver** receives the following gross monthly income:

a. **Hailea Ann Nalani Colver** is voluntarily unemployed. Based on **Hailea Ann Nalani Colver's** work experience, **Hailea Ann Nalani Colver** is capable of earning **0** per hour, or **\$7500** per month. (Utah Code 81-6-203)

45. The adjusted gross monthly income for **Hailea Ann Nalani Colver** is **\$7500**.

Child support (Utah Code Title 81, Chapter 6, Parts 1 and 2)

46. It is in the best interest of the children that **Evan Dean Colver** be ordered to pay child support to **Hailea Ann Nalani Colver** as follows:

a. **\$90.00** per month base support. This amount complies with the Utah Child Support Act.

47. Once a child is no longer eligible to receive child support, the support amount for the eligible children should be recalculated using the child support worksheet (Utah Code Title 81, Chapter 6, Parts 1 and 2). The parties may not divide the base child support award by the number of children and subtract that amount from the prior child support amount.

48. The **joint** custody worksheet was used to calculate child support.

49. The base child support amount using the joint custody calculation is **\$90** per month.

**Child support reduction for extended parent-time**

50. If a child lives with the non-custodial parent by court order or written agreement of the parties for:

- 25 of any 30 consecutive days, base child support will be reduced by 50% for each child who lives with the non-custodial parent during that time. (Utah Code 81-6-211(1)(a)).
- 12 of any 30 consecutive days, base child support will be reduced by 25% for each child who lives with the non-custodial parent during that time. (Utah Code 81-6-211(1)(b)).

The custodial parent's normal parent-time and holiday parent-time do not count as an interruption of the consecutive day requirement.

51. If a child receives cash assistance through the T.A.N.F. or F.E.P. programs, any agreement by the parties to reduce child support during extended parent-time must be approved by the Office of Recovery Services.

52. Child support will be paid as follows:

**Petitioner shall provide direct financial support for the minor children to Respondent on a monthly basis and additionally as reasonably needed for the care and support of the children.**

53. The issue of past-due child support may be decided by future court or administrative action.

54. **Evan Dean Colver** and **Hailea Ann Nalani Colver** will each pay half of any ORS fee.

- a. If a fee is withheld from payments to **Hailea Ann Nalani Colver**, **Evan Dean Colver** will reimburse **Hailea Ann Nalani Colver** for half the fee.

55. The parties must notify each other within 30 days of any change in their income.

56. The parties will do the following for child related support or expenses:

- a. Both parties agree that neither Evan Dean Colver nor Hailea Ann Nalani Colver shall request or receive alimony from the other now or in the future, subject to approval by the court handling the divorce proceedings.
- b. The parties state that they mutually agree that no child support payments shall be required between them. The parties understand that the court retains the authority under Utah law to review this arrangement and may modify it if the court determines it is not in the best interests of the child(ren).
- c. Each party affirms that they have had the opportunity to disclose their income, assets, and financial circumstances to the other prior to signing this agreement.

d. Petitioner requests that the Court consider Respondent's historical earning capacity when calculating child support. Respondent was previously employed earning approximately \$90,000 annually and possesses the education, skills, and work history necessary to obtain comparable employment. Petitioner believes the current unemployment situation is temporary and requests that income be imputed consistent with Utah law and Respondent's recent employment history.

57. The Office of Recovery Services (<https://ors.utah.gov/>) provides services to individuals who are seeking assistance in the collection or enforcement of child support orders.

### Dependent children for tax purposes

58. The parents may claim the parties' children as dependents/exemptions for tax purposes as follows:

59. **Hailea Ann Nalani Colver** may claim the parties' children as dependents/exemptions for tax purposes in odd numbered years. **Evan Dean Colver** may claim the parties' children as dependents/exemptions for tax purposes in even numbered years.

### Child health care (Utah Code 81-6-208)

60. The parties must provide health care coverage for the medical expenses of the dependent children. Health care coverage means coverage under which medical services are provided to a dependent child through: fee for service, a health maintenance organization, a preferred provider organization, any other type of private health insurance, or public health care coverage. Utah Code 81-6-101(14),

61. Both parents must maintain medical, hospital, and dental care insurance for the dependent children if it is available at reasonable cost. If medical insurance is not available at reasonable cost then both parents must ensure the children have health care coverage. This may require applying for public health care coverage, such as CHIP or Medicaid.

a. If, at any time, a dependent child is covered by the medical, hospital, or dental insurance plans of both parents, the coverage will be as follows:

- **Evan Dean Colver's** insurance will be primary coverage.
- **Hailea Ann Nalani Colver's** insurance will be secondary coverage.

b. If a parent remarries and that parent's dependent child is not covered by that parent's health, hospital, or dental insurance plan but is covered by a step-parent's plan, the coverage will be as follows:

- **Evan Dean Colver's** spouse's insurance will be primary coverage.
- **Hailea Ann Nalani Colver's** spouse's insurance will be secondary coverage.

c. Both parties will equally share the out-of-pocket costs of the insurance premiums.

d. Both parties will equally share all uninsured and unreimbursed medical and dental

expenses that are reasonable and necessary. This includes deductibles, co-insurance, and co-payments paid by a party for the dependent children.

e. The party who pays health care expenses must provide the other party written verification of the cost and payment within 30 days.

f. If a party does not follow this order and provide written verification, they may not be able to receive credit for health care expenses or recover the other party's share of the expenses.

g. On or before January 2 of each year, the party ordered to maintain coverage must provide verification of coverage to the other party, and ORS, if they are involved.

h. If there is any change in coverage, within 30 days of the change the party ordered to maintain coverage must notify the other party and ORS, if they are involved.

### Child care expenses (Utah Code 81-6-209)

62. Both parties will equally share all reasonable work, career, or occupational training-related child care expenses.

a. The party who pays child care expenses must provide the other party written verification of the cost and identity of the child care provider. This must be done when a provider is first hired, and any time the other party asks for the information. The party incurring or paying child care expenses must notify the other party of any change of a child care provider or monthly expense. This must be done within 30 calendar days of the change.

b. The party not directly paying for child care must pay their share of child care expenses as soon as they receive verification of the expenses.

c. If a party does **not** follow the order and provide written verification, they may not receive credit for work, career, or occupational training-related child care expenses or recover the other party's share of the expenses.

### Public assistance statement – Office of Recovery Services (ORS) (Utah Code 81-6-106(2)-(3))

63. Neither party has received or is receiving public assistance from the State of Utah.

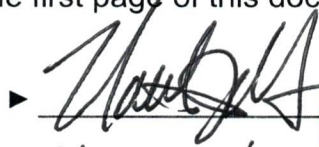

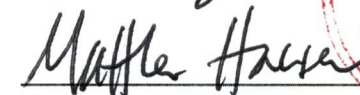

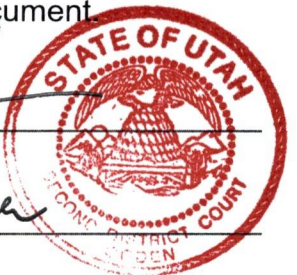
