DECREE OF DIVORCE

This matter is before the court upon a stipulation of the parties. The parties having agreed, having previously entered Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law, the Court, hereby DECREES as follows:

1. The bonds of matrimony and the marriage contract heretofore existing between the Petitioner and the Respondent are dissolved, and the Petitioner is awarded a Decree of Divorce on the ground of irreconcilable differences; the said Decree to become absolute and final upon entry by the Court.

7. OTHER PERSONAL PROPERTY. During the course of the marriage, the parties acquired certain items of personal property. Each party should be awarded any personal property that is currently in his or her possession.
8. REAL PROPERTY. The Petitioner and Respondent purchased real property, a marital home, located in Weber County, State of Utah. The Petitioner is awarded the marital home along with all debt associated with the home.
9. INCOME TAX. The parties shall file separate tax returns for 2025 and all future tax years.
10. MAIDEN NAME. Respondent may resume use of her maiden name, Chantil Hope Hughes.
11. DOCUMENTS. Each of the parties should be ordered to execute and deliver to the other any documents necessary to implement the provisions of the Decree of Divorce entered by the court.
12. ATTORNEYS FEES AND COSTS. The Petitioner and Respondent shall pay their own attorney's fees and costs of the Court incurred in this matter.

13. COOPERATION. Both parties should cooperate to execute any deed, title or other document needed to effect this Decree of Divorce.
