6. **Tabytha Jones** and **Nathaniel Jones** have physical custody of our child(ren), and are the only people who have custody, child support, and parent-time rights to our child(ren).

## PARENTING PLAN

This Parenting Plan is being filed in good faith.

This parenting plan is agreed to by **Tabytha Jones** and **Nathaniel Jones**.

### Children - custody

(Utah Code Title 81, Chapter 9, Part 3)

7. It is in the children's best interest that the parties be awarded Joint Legal and Joint Physical Custody. **Tabytha Jones** is filing this Parenting Plan and verifies the plan is filed in good faith.

8. The children should reside in **Tabytha Jones**'s home **183** overnights each year and in **Nathaniel Jones**'s home **182** overnights each year.

9. Parent-time will be equal between the parties. (Utah Code 81-9-305 and 81-6-206(7))

## Parent-time transfers

12. Pick-up and drop-off ("transfers") of the children for parent-time will be as described

below:

The parties will make arrangements for pick up, delivery and return of the children prior to each scheduled parent-time.

### **Curbside transfers**

13. There will not be curbside transfers. The parent/person dropping-off or picking-up a child may accompany the children to the other parent/person when parent-time transfers are made.

### **Decision-making**

14. Each parent will make day-to-day decisions for the children during the time they are caring for the children. Either parent may make emergency decisions affecting the health or safety of the children. A parent who makes an emergency decision must share the decision with the other parent as soon as reasonably possible.

**Joint decision-making.** The parents will share responsibility for making major decisions about the children. If there is a disagreement, the parents will resolve the dispute as provided in the Resolving disputes section below.

### **Education plan**

15. The school the children will attend is based on **Tabytha Jones's** home residence.

16. Tabytha Jones and Nathaniel Jones has authority to check the children out of school. Tabytha Jones and Nathaniel Jones has access to the children during school. If the parents cannot agree, education decisions will be made by Tabytha Jones.

### **Communication with each other**

17. Parents will communicate with each other by any method.

### **Communication with the children**

18. The parents agree they will:

- provide age-appropriate help to the children to communicate with the other parent.
- give the children privacy during their communication with the other parent. The parents will not interfere with or monitor communication between the children and the other parent.

19. Parents and children may communicate with each other whenever the children choose.

- By any method

### **Records and information sharing**

20. Both parents will have access to records and the ability to consult with providers regarding education, child care, and health care.

## Travel by the children

21. During their parent-time, the parent may consent for the children to travel with a sports team, religious group, school group, relatives, friends, by themselves, or with others.
22. If the children will be travelling for more than **1** days, the parent arranging the travel will notify the other parent at least **30** days in advance. That parent will give the other parent the travel schedule, locations and phone numbers at least **30** days in advance. In case of emergency, the parent will provide as much notice as possible.

## Child care

23. A child care provider for our children must be:  
A licensed child care provider.

## Relocation of a parent

24. Neither parent may relocate with the minor children more than **50** miles from their current residence without a written agreement signed by the parties or further court order.
25. If either parent lives more than 149 miles away from the other or the parents live in separate countries, costs for the children's travel expenses for parent-time will be shared equally.
26. If a parent has been found in contempt for not being current on all support obligations, and they do not have primary physical care of the child, they will be responsible for the child's related travel expenses.
27. Reimbursement for the child's travel expenses must be made within 30 days of receipt of documents detailing those expenses.

## Resolving disputes

28. If the parents need to resolve a dispute regarding the children, they will discuss the issues in good faith and try to reach an agreement based on what is best for their children. If the parents are unable to agree, they will go to the following before bringing the issue to the court:
- a. **Counseling**

## Changing the plan

This plan remains in effect until changed. A change comes from a modification of a court order.

29. A joint physical custody arrangement may result in denial of cash assistance under the Employment Support Act, Title 35A, Chapter 3, of the Utah Code.

# END OF PARENTING PLAN

Income: Petitioner (Tabytha Jones) (Utah Code 81-6-203)

30. **Tabytha Jones's** gross monthly income for child support purposes is **\$0**. **Tabytha Jones** receives the following gross monthly income:

- a. **Tabytha Jones** does not have any countable income from any source.
- b. **Tabytha Jones** is ordered to pay **\$528.00** per month in child support for children not part of this case. This amount is subtracted from their gross monthly income for the child support calculation.

Income: Respondent (Nathaniel Jones) (Utah Code 81-6-203)

31. **Nathaniel Jones's** gross monthly income for child support purposes is **\$6370**. **Nathaniel Jones** receives the following gross monthly income:

- a. **Nathaniel Jones** is employed at **CVT trucking**. **Nathaniel Jones** earns **\$6370** gross (pre-tax) monthly income working a 40-hour a week job or less.
- b. **Nathaniel Jones** is ordered to pay **\$410.00** per month in child support for children not part of this case. This amount is subtracted from their gross monthly income for the child support calculation.

32. The adjusted gross monthly income for **Nathaniel Jones** is **\$5960**.

Child support (Utah Code Title 81, Chapter 6, Parts 1 and 2)

33. It is in the best interest of the children that **Nathaniel Jones** be ordered to pay child support to **Tabytha Jones** as follows:

a. **\$656.00** per month base support. This amount complies with the Utah Child Support Act.

34. Once a child is no longer eligible to receive child support, the support amount for the eligible children should be recalculated using the child support worksheet (Utah Code Title 81, Chapter 6, Parts 1 and 2). The parties may not divide the base child support award by the number of children and subtract that amount from the prior child support amount.

35. The **joint** custody worksheet was used to calculate child support.

36. The base child support amount using the joint custody calculation is **\$656** per month.

**Child support reduction for extended parent-time**

37. If a child lives with the non-custodial parent by court order or written agreement of the parties for:

- 25 of any 30 consecutive days, base child support will be reduced by 50% for each child who lives with the non-custodial parent during that time. (Utah Code 81-6-211(1)(a)).
- 12 of any 30 consecutive days, base child support will be reduced by 25% for each child who lives with the non-custodial parent during that time. (Utah Code 81-6-211(1)(b)).

The custodial parent's normal parent-time and holiday parent-time do not count as an interruption of the consecutive day requirement.

38. If a child receives cash assistance through the T.A.N.F. or F.E.P. programs, any agreement by the parties to reduce child support during extended parent-time must be approved by the Office of Recovery Services.

39. The person ordered to receive child support can request mandatory income withholding (Utah Code 62A-11 parts 4 and 5). If support is past due, the State of Utah may take federal or state tax refunds or rebates and apply the amounts to the child support owed.

a. Withheld income will be sent to the Office of Recovery Services (ORS) until all past-due support is paid. Child support payments will be sent to:  
2540 Washington Blvd., 7th Floor Ogden, Utah 84401  
unless ORS gives notice that payments should be sent elsewhere.

40. If ORS begins mandatory income withholding, child support is due on the first day of each month and will be past due on the first day of the next month.

41. The issue of past-due child support may be decided by future court or administrative action.

42. **Nathaniel Jones** will pay any ORS fees. If **Tabytha Jones** is the ORS applicant and the fees are withheld from payments to **Tabytha Jones**, **Nathaniel Jones** will reimburse **Tabytha Jones**.

43. The parties must notify each other within 30 days of any change in their income.

44. The Office of Recovery Services (<https://ors.utah.gov/>) provides services to individuals who are seeking assistance in the collection or enforcement of child support orders.

## Dependent children for tax purposes

45. As long as **Tabytha Jones** is current on all child support and other court-ordered financial obligations, **Tabytha Jones** may claim the following children as dependents/exemptions for tax purposes as allowed by law:

a. **Finley Jones**

46. As long as **Nathaniel Jones** is current on all child support and other court-ordered financial obligations, **Nathaniel Jones** may claim the following children as dependents/exemptions for tax purposes as allowed by law:

b. **Emery Jones**

## Child health care (Utah Code 81-6-208)

47. The parties must provide health care coverage for the medical expenses of the dependent children. Health care coverage means coverage under which medical services are provided to a dependent child through: fee for service, a health maintenance organization, a preferred provider organization, any other type of private health insurance, or public health care coverage. Utah Code 81-6-101(14),

48. The parent who is able to obtain the most affordable medical, hospital, and dental

insurance for the dependent children must maintain medical, hospital, and dental care insurance for the dependent children if it is available at reasonable cost. If medical insurance is not available at reasonable cost then both parents must ensure the children have health care coverage. This may require applying for public health care coverage, such as CHIP or Medicaid.

- a. If, at any time, a dependent child is covered by the medical, hospital, or dental insurance plans of both parents, the coverage will be as follows:
  - **Nathaniel Jones's** insurance will be primary coverage.
  - **Tabytha Jones's** insurance will be secondary coverage.
- b. If a parent remarries and that parent's dependent child is not covered by that parent's health, hospital, or dental insurance plan but is covered by a step-parent's plan, the coverage will be as follows:
  - **Nathaniel Jones's** spouse's insurance will be primary coverage.
  - **Tabytha Jones's** spouse's insurance will be secondary coverage.
- c. Both parties will equally share the out-of-pocket costs of the insurance premiums.
- d. Both parties will equally share all uninsured and unreimbursed medical and dental expenses that are reasonable and necessary. This includes deductibles, co-insurance, and co-payments paid by a party for the dependent children.
- e. The party who pays health care expenses must provide the other party written verification of the cost and payment within 30 days.
- f. If a party does not follow this order and provide written verification, they may not be able to receive credit for health care expenses or recover the other party's share of the expenses.
- g. On or before January 2 of each year, the party ordered to maintain coverage must provide verification of coverage to the other party, and ORS, if they are involved.
- h. If there is any change in coverage, within 30 days of the change the party ordered to maintain coverage must notify the other party and ORS, if they are involved.

#### Child care expenses (Utah Code 81-6-209)

49. All reasonable work, career, or occupational training-related child care expenses will be paid as follows

#### Public assistance statement – Office of Recovery Services (ORS) (Utah Code 81-6-106(2)-(3))

50. Neither party has received or is receiving public assistance from the State of Utah.

#### Personal property (Utah Code Title 81, Chapters 1, 4, 6, and 9)

51. All personal property not addressed in the divorce should be divided as the parties have already divided it.

## Debts

52. The parties are not aware of any debts from the marriage. If any debts exist, each debt will be the responsibility of the party who incurred the debt.

## Real property

53. The parties do not have any real property that is marital property. The parties do not need a court order about real property.

## Alimony

54. Neither party will pay alimony.

## Retirement money

55. The parties do not need a court order about retirement money.

## Duty to sign documents

56. The parties will sign all documents necessary to comply with the divorce decree within 60 days from entry of the decree. If a party fails to sign a document within 60 days, the other party may ask the court to appoint someone to sign the document. (Utah Rule of Civil Procedure 70)
