





## To Play

- 1. Click the Open button to open the Open dialog box.
- Use TheRecord Navigator to navigate through Search Folders, Date Folders and Location Folders until you
  reveal a content type. FTR Gold content is listed as FTR Audio (.wav) while ForTheRecord content is listed
  as TheRecord Audio/Video Media (.trm)
- 3. Double click the required content, or selct it and click Open.
- 4. Click the Play button or depress the play switch on the foot control to play.
- 5. Click the Play button or release the play switch on the foot control to stop play.
- 6. Click the Scan Forward button or depress the fast forward switch on the foot control to move rapidly forward.
- 7. Click the Scan Back button or depress the rewind switch on the foot control to move rapidly back.
- Drag the Master Volume Slider up or down to adjust the overall volume, or drag the Channel Volume Slider up or down to adjust individual channels.

- \* These keyboard shortcuts are global. They will operate regardless of which program you are using. Avoid using these keys for word processing macros.
- \*\* These keyboard shortcuts do not work when Playing At End.

The keyboard shortcuts for channel selection operate differently to the mouse and are designed for transcript typists to make voice identification quicker.
