I. WELCOME AND APPROVAL OF MINUTES

Randy Dryer welcomed the Committee members to the meeting. Jessica Van Buren introduced Kylie Newsom who is a Hinckley Institute intern for the law library.

The committee discussed the December 17, 2017 minutes. Randy Dryer moved to approve the minutes with no changes. Stewart Ralphs seconded the motion and it passed unanimously.

Mr. Dryer said the Education Subcommittee of the LPP Committee would like to prioritize family law forms and have them completed by June. Mr. Ralphs will discuss the proposed list with the subcommittee. Mr. Dryer asked that those forms be completed by April. Mr. Ralphs will email Mr. Dryer when the subcommittee reviews the family law forms.

The committee noted they would need to address the Order to Show Cause form with Brent Johnson. Cathy Dupont will find out whether there is a propose rule pending that would affect the Order to Show Cause forms. Ms. Dupont agreed to investigate and report back on the status and timeline of the current effort to revise certain court rules and identify what forms may be impacted if the proposed revised rules are adopted.

II. FUTURE MEETING DATES

Mr. Dryer proposed returning to Monday meetings in May. The committee agreed to meet on Mondays. A Doodle poll will be circulated to choose meeting dates before May.

III. FORMS STATUS SUMMARY

Jessica Van Buren presented a forms status summary. The summary will be updated as forms move through the process.

IV. FAMILY LAW SUBCOMMITEE UPDATE

Mr. Ralphs said the parenting plan should be complete at the subcommittee meeting later today. They will next review the forms involving petitions to modify child support, custody and parent-time.

The Stylistics Subcommittee will review the financial declaration form. It is not expected that there will be many changes.

V. GENERIC MOTIONS

Mr. Dryer said there is a proposal to exclude juvenile court from generic motions. The committee agreed that there should be a separate set of forms for juvenile court. Jessica Van Buren said that there are existing juvenile motion forms that can be used as a starting point.

The committee reviewed the motions.

Your property may be taken to pay a creditor.

You have a deadline of 14 days in which to object.

1. A judgment for money has been entered against you, and the creditor has taken steps to take your money or property to pay the judgment.

If you think the creditor shouldn't be taking your money or property, you may object to the execution by taking the steps below.

You may not use these steps to challenge why the judgment was entered against you. If you think the judgment should not have been entered against you, you must file a timely motion to set the judgment aside. (Utah Rule of Civil Procedure 60(b).) See the court's Motion to Set Aside Judgment page for more information about the process and forms: www.utcourts.gov/howto/judgment/set_aside/.

- 2. If you are the judgment debtor (the person who owes money) in this case, your rights may be affected. Read this notice and take steps to protect your rights.

- Certain furnishings, appliances, carpets, animals, books, musical instruments, works of art and heirlooms.
- Provisions for 12 months.
- Wearing apparel, not including jewelry or furs.
- Beds and bedding.
- Certain works of art.
- Compensatory damages from bodily injury or wrongful death.
- The proceeds of certain life insurance contracts and trusts.
- Certain books, implements and tools of a trade.
- A personal motor vehicle up to a specified amount.
- A motor vehicle used in trade or business.
- Part of your wages.
- Property of a person who did not have a judgment entered against him or her, such as the co-owner of the property being held.
- 6. Some property is exempt no matter how much it is worth. For example, a refrigerator.
- 7. Other property may be exempt depending on its worth. See the Utah Exemptions Act (Utah Code Title 78B, Chapter 5, Part 5) for more information about exemptions. There is no exemption solely because you are having trouble paying your debts.
- 8. If you believe:

NOTICE OF GARNISHMENT AND EXEMPTIONS

Please read this carefully.

Your property may be taken to pay a creditor.

You have a deadline of 14 days in which to object.

1. A judgment for money has been entered against you, and the creditor has taken steps to garnish (seize) your money or property to pay the judgment.

If you think the creditor has shouldn't be garnishing some of your money or property, you may object to the garnishment by taking the steps described below.

You may not use these steps to challenge why the judgment was entered against you. If you think the judgment should not have been entered against you, you must file a timely motion to set the judgment aside. (Utah Rule of Civil Procedure 60(b).) See the court's Motion to Set Aside Judgment page for more information about the process and forms: www.utcourts.gov/howto/judgment/set_aside/.

- 2. If you are the judgment debtor (the person who owes money) in this case, your rights may be affected. Read this notice and take steps to protect your rights.
- 3. If you are not the judgment debtor in this action, you may have an interest in the judgment debtor's property and your rights may be affected. Read this notice and take steps to protect your rights.
- 4. The court has ordered the garnishee (someone who possesses your property) to hold your money or property. This means that you cannot get the property and it may be used to pay a judgment creditor.

- Compensatory damages from bodily injury or wrongful death.
- The proceeds of certain life insurance contracts and trusts.
- Certain books, implements and tools of a trade.
- A personal motor vehicle up to a specified amount.
- A motor vehicle used in trade or business.
- Part of your wages.
- Property of a person who did not have a judgment entered against him or her, such as the co-owner of the property being held.
- 6. See the Utah Exemptions Act (Utah Code Title 78B, Chapter 5, Part 5) for more information about exemptions. There is no exemption solely because you are having trouble paying your debts.
- 7. If you believe:
 - the Writ of Garnishment was not issued correctly,
 - the Answers to Interrogatories are wrong,
 - the judgment creditor owes you money, or
 - you are entitled to an exemption,
