I. WELCOME AND APPROVAL OF MINUTES:

Judge Taylor welcomed the committee members to the meeting. The Committee discussed the minutes from the June 10 meeting. No revision was made to the minutes. Mary Westby moved to

approve the full minutes. Judge Elizabeth Lindsley seconded the motion. The motion unanimously passed.

II. ADDITIONAL OCAP DOCUMENTS:

The committee determined at the last meeting to include these documents as part of the series of divorce forms. The Stylistics Committee has reviewed the documents. The documents are brought to this committee for further discussion and review.

• Certificate of readiness for trial:

This document will be used in both domestic and civil cases. The committee discussed and made recommended language changes to the form. The committee determined that paragraph 7, regarding proposed settlements, should be removed as it is not applicable in civil matters once the pretrial hearing has been held. The committee recommended renaming the form called Proposed Settlement to Trial Issues.

Following further discussion, Stewart Ralphs motioned to accept the changes as recommended, and to eliminate paragraphs 6 and 7 from the form. Cyndie Bayles seconded the motion. The committee voted and the motion unanimously passed.

With no further discussion, Mr. Ralphs motioned to approve and accept the form as discussed and modified by the committee. Nathanael Player seconded the motion. The motion was unanimously approved.

• Proposed settlement – domestic cases:

The committee recommended changing the title of the form to "Trial Issues" as previously discussed. The petitioner will be instructed to provide a copy to all parties, however, will not be required to complete a certificate of service.

With no further discussions, Judge Lindsley motioned to accept the form as amended. Kim Allard seconded the motion. The motion was unanimously approved.

• Proposed settlement – other civil cases:

In congruency with the domestic cases, the committee recommended changing the title of the form to "Trial Issues" as previously discussed. The committee discussed and recommended minor language changes form. The committee discussed removal of petition of divorce classes from the form. The petitioner will be instructed to provide a copy to all parties, however, will not be required to complete a certificate of service.

With no further discussions, Mr. Player moved to accept the form with recommended changes. Kara Mann seconded the motion. The motion was approved with a majority vote. One committee member objected to the motion.

• Motion for leave to amend:

The committee discussed and made minor language change recommendations to the form.

With no further discussions, Judge Lindsley motioned to accept the form as recommended by the committee. Mr. Ralphs seconded the motion. The motion was unanimously approved.

• Declaration of jurisdiction and grounds for divorce :

The committee discussed and reviewed this declaration form. The committee did not have any concerns or issues with the form.

With no further discussions, Mr. Ralphs moved to approve the form. Judge Birch seconded the motion. The motion was unanimously approved.

• Income verification and statement of compliance with child support guidelines: The committee discussed and made language changes.

With no further discussions, Judge Lindsley moved to approve the form. Ms. Mann seconded the motion. The motion was unanimously approved.

III. MOTION FOR ORDERS REGARDING RELOCATION:

Mr. Player noted that this is a proposed change to a form that has already been approved by the Judicial Council. The Family Forms Subcommittee recommends the proposed changes. The committee reviewed the changes and did not have any other changes or recommendations to make.

With no further discussions, Judge Lindsley moved to approve and accept the form as recommended by the subcommittee. Mr. Ralphs seconded the motion. The motion was unanimously approved.

IV. DEFAULT JUDGMENT:

• Motion for default certificate:

There is a current form already out on the court website. The form needs to be cleaned up, as it is currently unusable by Licensed Paralegal Practitioner. The certificate of service needs to be included in the form. The form is not ready to be updated on the website. Judge Birch will be meeting with Judge Lawrence to review the default judgment forms and will provide the committee an update at the next meeting.

With no further discussions, Judge Taylor recommended that the committee table these forms until the next meeting. No motion was made. The committee agreed with Judge Taylor's recommendation. Guy Galli will review how often the motion for default certificate is used in state courts.

• Default certificate:

Being held over for discussion at the next meeting.

• Military service declaration:

Being held over for discussion at the next meeting.

• Military service order:

The committee discussed that military service members should not be defaulted if they fall under the Military Service Act. The committee discussed that federal rules are different from state rules, and therefore the order would be different under any military rules. Judge Taylor recommends that the order be tabled until the next meeting for further discussion.

Judge Lindsley asked that the committee review these forms before the next meeting and come prepared to discuss both state and federal practices. Minhvan Brimhall will send the committee a reminder email before the end of the day.

The court has considered the Motion for Inquiry Into Competency and Certificate of Good Faith.

The court orders:

The Department of Human Services must

- 1. Conduct an examination into the competency of [CLIENT NAME]. (Utah Code 78A-6-1302.)
- 2. Have the minor examined by a forensic evaluator not involved in the minor's current treatment. The forensic evaluator must have experience in juvenile forensic evaluations and juvenile brain development. If it becomes apparent the minor may not be competent due to an intellectual disability or related condition, the forensic evaluator must be experienced in that intellectual disability or related condition.

The parties must

- 3. Provide to the Department of Human Services information and materials relevant to the determination of the minor's competency, including:
 - the motion,
 - the arrest or incident reports about the charged offense,
 - the minor's known delinquency history information,
 - any part of the minor's probation record related to competency,
 - any known prior mental health evaluations and treatment.
 - the records about the minor's education as allowed under 20 U.S.C. §1232g (b)(1)(E)(ii)(I),
 - records of diagnosis or treatment of substance abuse disorders.

All disclosures must be consistent with 42 C.F.R. Part 2, governing the confidentiality of Alcohol and Drug Abuse Patient Records.

This information must be provided within seven days of this order.

The parents or guardian and minor must

4. Sign releases required to give information to the forensic evaluator.

The forensic evaluator must

- 5. Conduct an examination to determine whether the minor is currently suffering from a mental illness, intellectual disability, or related condition, or developmental immaturity impacting the minor's present ability to consult with counsel with a reasonable degree of rational understanding and whether the minor has a rational as well as factual understanding of the proceedings.
- 6. Consider the minor's present ability to:
 - understand the charges or allegations;
 - communicate facts, events, and states of mind;
 - understand the range of possible penalties associated with the allegations;
 - engage in reasoned choice of legal strategies and options;
 - understand the adversarial nature of the proceedings;
 - manifest behavior sufficient to allow the court to proceed;
 - testify relevantly; and
 - any other factor determined to be relevant to the forensic evaluator.
- 7. Write a report informing the court of the forensic evaluator's opinion concerning the minor's competency. If the forensic evaluator's opinion is that the minor is not competent to proceed, the report must include:
 - the nature of the minor's mental illness, intellectual disability or related condition, or developmental immaturity;
 - the relationship of the minor's mental illness, intellectual disability or related condition, or developmental immaturity to the minor's incompetence;
 - whether there is a substantial likelihood that the minor may attain competency in the foreseeable future;
 - the amount of time estimated for the minor to achieve competency if the minor undergoes competency attainment treatment, including medication;
 - the sources of information used by the forensic evaluator; and
 - the basis for clinical findings and opinions.
- 9. Provide the initial report to the court, prosecution, defense, and guardian ad litem, if applicable, within 30 days of the receipt of the court order. If the forensic evaluator needs additional time, the court may grant an additional 15 days upon written request by forensic evaluator.
