RE: Safe at Home Program and protective order form changes

The Safe at Home Program (SAHP) is an address confidentiality program administered by the Commission on Criminal and Juvenile Justice (UCA 77-38-6). A program participant can show proof of their participation in the program (typically a program card or letter), and government agencies are required to redact documents containing the participant's actual address (any documents within the 90 days before program enrollment). Government agencies are also required to use the assigned address provided by the SAHP participant instead of their actual address for service.

For protective orders, SAHP participants can request that the respondent stay away from their home, and the courts cannot list the participants' actual address in the protective order. SAHP participants are also able to waive the address confidentiality provision under <u>UCA 77-36-611(11)(b)(ii)</u>, so the courts can share their address with law enforcement agencies for enforcement purposes. In the shared forms, you will see the waiver and the stay away language for these different options.
