

RE: Court Interpreter Advisory Panel Membership

Rule 3-306, CJA, establishes a Court Interpreter Advisory Panel, with members appointed by the Judicial Council. The function of the Advisory Panel is to develop policies concerning court interpreters, to consult with the administrative office regarding the establishment of programs to certify court interpreters, and to review and respond to allegations of violation of the Code of Professional Conduct, including decertification or other disciplinary measures.

The Panel, which has been in effect since 1997, is comprised of the following members:

One District Judge - Judge Lynn Davis, Fourth District
One Juvenile Judge - Judge Diane Wilkins, Second District Juvenile
One Justice Court Judge - Judge David Miller, Centerville City
One Court Executive - Larry Gobelman, Third District
One Clerk of Court - Sheryl Morris, First District
One Juvenile Probation Staff - Russell Hagood, Third District
One Court Interpreter Coordinator - Carolyn Smitherman, Fifth District
Two Court Interpreters - Grant Andersen and Tony Ngo
One Expert in the Field of Linguistics - Prof. Maurice Mixco, U. of U.
One Attorney -James Valdez, Public Defender, Salt Lake

As of April, 2000, the first terms of three of the members will expire: Judge Lynn Davis, Carolyn Smitherman, and Grant Andersen. The Advisory Panel recommends that Judge Davis and Grant Andersen be appointed to serve second three-year terms. The Panel recommends that the Interpreter Coordinator position be filled by Pat Tingey, Interpreter Coordinator for the Third District Juvenile

Court. The incumbent, Ms. Smitherman, was a dedicated Panel member who was diligent in her attendance at meetings. However, her actual experience with the coordinator function was quite limited. Ms. Tingey, on the other hand, has very extensive experience with the interpreter coordinator function, providing coordination for the entire Third District Juvenile Court. The Panel members felt that this experience would allow her more relevant input to the Panel's work than Ms. Smitherman was able to provide.

Thank you for your consideration of these recommendations. If you agree with the proposal, I request that this matter be placed on the consent calendar of the next Judicial Council meeting.
