Overview of the Justice Courts

- 110 Justice Courts
 - Down from 111 following the Council's approval of an Interlocal Agreement between Carbon County and Wellington
- 75 judges
 - Down from 77 due to the departure of
 - Judge Terry Moore, who resigned in May from Wellsville
 - Judge Patrick Lambert, who retired in July from Farr West, North Ogden, Pleasant View, Uintah, and Washington Terrace
 - Upcoming Retirements
 - Judge Poulson from Duchesne County
 - Judge Hartmann from Daggett County
 - Judge Baxter from Salt Lake City
 - 60 male, 15 female
 - 50 lawyers, 25 non-lawyers



Last Year's Goals

- Continue to Strengthen the Board's Relationship with the AOC
