IV. Notice of Publication in Termination of Parental Rights Actions	[PRESENTER] BRENT BARTHOLOMEW
<p>Discussion: Carol reviewed Tim Shea's analysis of the issues, including a recommendation to identify the child by initials, month and year of birth and the parent's full name. As of January, 2010, all service by publication will include the petition and be on the internet, as well as in a paper. This is a much more "permanent" record of publication. 78A-6-109 and URCP 4 (content of summons) govern the issue and would allow publication as recommended by Tim. CJA Rule 4-202.09(9) also suggests publication by the child's initials and month/year of birth. (Note, however, that committee members also recommended using the date of birth as well as the month/year). Concerns were also raised about CJA provisions regarding placing non-public information in a public record. Additional discussion followed regarding whether the mother's full name should be published, in addition to the father's name. The 2nd District is already using initials in published notices.</p> <p>The suggestion was to place the new requirement in URJP 18 (Summons; service of process; notice). Katie will forward Tim's October 28th email to the entire committee for consideration at the next meeting. URJP 18(c) also refers to Rule 4 of the Rules of Civil Procedure. Brent Bartholomew will prepare an additional draft for discussion at the next meeting.</p>
