UTAH JUDICIAL COUNCIL'S PRETRIAL REFORM SUBCOMMITTEE

Charge

Due to the changing landscape in pretrial caselaw, the Utah Judicial Council created a small 6-person subcommittee to develop a comprehensive proposal for consideration by the Council's Standing Committee on Pretrial Release and Supervision. The subcommittee has been charged with:

- Conducting research into other states and identifying best practices nationally,
- Creating the "perfect" pretrial model,
- Determining how Utah's current processes differ from the "perfect" model,
- Developing the perfect model for Utah,
- Setting a goal for achieving the Utah model,
- Identifying incremental milestones,
- Identifying challenges to achieving milestones (statutory amendments, funding, pretrial supervision resources, etc.),
- Recommending solutions to each challenge,
- Developing a detailed plan of action, and
- Submitting a comprehensive proposal to the Standing Pretrial Release and Supervision Committee for consideration.
