2 (a) Bar Examination. The Bar Examination consists of the UBE. ~~To qualify as the~~
3 ~~UBE, a~~All components of the Bar Examination must be taken in the same examination
4 administration and given according to the standards established by the NCBE.

5 (b) ~~Exam schedule~~components. The Bar Examination ~~components are~~is administered
6 ~~on the last consecutive Tuesday and Wednesday in February and July. The MEE and~~
7 ~~MPT are administered on Tuesday and the MBE is administered on Wednesday~~ the MEE,
8 MPT, and MBE.

9 (c) ~~MBE score transferability. The Bar will accept MBE scores transferred from~~
10 ~~another jurisdiction only if the MBE is taken concurrent with the Written Component in~~
11 ~~Utah. To transfer a MBE score, an Applicant must send a written transfer request, along~~
12 ~~with the prescribed fee, to the NCBE.~~(c) The Bar Examination is administered only for
13 the purpose of admission to the Bar.
