

Rule 14-101. Definitions.

1 As used in this article:

2 (a) “Bar” means the Utah State Bar;

3 (b) “Board” means Board of Commissioners of the Utah State Bar;

4 (c) “discipline” means disbarment, suspension, probation, reprimand, ~~or~~ admonition or
5 delicensure;

6 (d) “member” means a lawyer who has been admitted to the Bar, and who holds a current
7 license, the classifications of which are to be set forth hereinafter; ~~and~~

8 (e) “Licensed Paralegal Practitioner” means a person licensed by the Utah Supreme Court to
9 provide limited legal representation in the areas of (1) temporary separation, divorce, parentage,
10 cohabitant abuse, civil stalking, and custody and support; (2) forcible entry and detainer and unlawful
11 detainer; or (3) debt collection matters in which the dollar amount in issue does not exceed the
12 statutory limit for small claims cases; and

13 (e)(f) “Supreme Court” means the Utah Supreme Court.
