

1 **Rule 20. Discovery generally.**

2 (a) Discovery involving adjudications of delinquency, offenses by adults against minors,
3 and proceedings brought pursuant to Title 80, Chapter 6, Part 5, Transfer to District
4 Court~~Section 78A-6-702 and Section 78A-6-703~~ shall be conducted in accordance with
5 ~~Utah R. Cr. P. 16~~Rule 16 of the Utah Rules of Criminal Procedure, except where limited
6 by these rules, the Code of Judicial Administration, or the ~~Juvenile Court Act~~Utah
7 Juvenile Code.

8 (b) In substantiation cases, no later than thirty days prior to trial, parties shall provide to
9 each other information necessary to support its claims or defenses unless otherwise
10 ordered by the court.

11 (c) Rule 26.1 of the Utah Rules of Civil Procedure does not apply in any juvenile
12 proceedings unless there is a showing of good cause and it is ordered by the court.

13 (d) In all other cases, discovery shall be conducted pursuant to these rules unless
14 modified by a showing of good cause and by order of the court.
