

1 **Rule 14-1111. Exemption from future testimony and confidentiality of records and**
2 **information.**

3 (a) Exemption from future testimony. No Fee Dispute Resolution Committee member
4 participating in a fee dispute ~~decision~~ arbitration or mediation ~~proceeding shall~~ may be
5 called as a witness in any subsequent legal proceeding related to the fee dispute.

6 (b) Confidentiality of records and information. Records and ~~in~~ information ~~and~~
7 ~~documentation~~ submitted in a fee dispute proceeding shall be deemed confidential and
8 ~~shall~~ may not be disclosed other than to enforce a written decision or as provided in
9 paragraph (c).

10 ~~(c) Notwithstanding the above,~~ (c) Disclosure of confidential information. Confidential
11 information in the Utah State Bar's possession may be disclosed to law enforcement to
12 the extent disclosure is necessary to prevent reasonably certain death or substantial
13 bodily harm. Confidential information in the Utah State Bar's possession may also be
14 disclosed if the request is made to the Bar by:

15 (a~~1~~) an agency authorized to investigate the qualifications of persons for admission
16 to practice law;

17 (b~~2~~) an agency authorized to investigate the qualifications of persons for
18 government employment;

19 (c~~3~~) a lawyer discipline enforcement agency; or

20 (d~~4~~) an agency authorized to investigate the qualifications of judicial candidates.
