

1 **Article 2. Bylaws.**

2 Rule 14-201. Definitions.

3 As used in this article:

4 (a) "Bar" means Utah State Bar, a corporation incorporated, registered and domiciled in
5 Utah and designated as a Section 501(c)(6) organization under the United States
6 Internal Revenue Code;

7 (b) "Board" means the Board of Commissioners of the Utah State Bar;

8 (c) "commissioner" means a member of the Board;

9 (d) "Executive Committee" means a committee of not fewer than three members of the
10 Board as set forth in these Bylaws;

11 (e) "executive director" means the executive director of the Bar;

12 (f) "member" means a lawyer who has been admitted to the Bar who holds a current
13 active or inactive license, or is a licensed foreign legal consultant;

14 (g) "president" means the president of the Board;

15 (h) "president-elect" means the president-elect of the Board; and

16 (i) "Supreme Court" means the Utah Supreme Court.

17 (j) "Licensed Paralegal Practitioner" means a person licensed by the Utah Supreme Court to
18 provide limited legal representation in the areas of (1) temporary separation, divorce, parentage,
19 cohabitant abuse, civil stalking, custody and support, and name change; (2) forcible entry and
20 detainer; or (3) debt collection matters in which the dollar amount in issue does not exceed the
21 statutory limit for small claims cases.
