Rule 32. Initiation of ungovernability and runaway cases.

(a) Proceedings involving a ~~minor~~child alleged to be beyond control of the ~~minor's~~ child's parent, guardian or lawful custodian ~~or school authorities~~, or alleged to be a runaway, shall be initiated by petition.

(b) A petition shall be accepted by the clerk only if it is filed by the Division of Child and Family Services or a contract agency of the Division.

(c) The petition must allege the earnest and persistent efforts by the agency, the ~~minor's~~child's out of control behavior, the behavior or other condition that endangers the ~~minor's~~child's welfare or the welfare of others, and the actions taken which have failed to correct the behavior. In the alternative, the allegations may be made by affidavit accompanying the petition.
