

1 **Rule 14-703. Qualifications for admission of Student Applicants.**

2 *Effective: 5/1/2016*

3 (a) Requirements of Student Applicants. The burden of proof is on the Applicant to establish by
4 clear and convincing evidence that ~~she or he~~ the Applicant:

5 ~~(a)~~(1) has paid the prescribed fees and timely filed the required Complete Application as a
6 Student Applicant in accordance with Rule 14-707;

7 ~~(a)~~(2) is at least 21 years old;

8 ~~(a)~~(3) has graduated with a First Professional Degree in law from an Approved Law
9 School;

10 ~~(a)~~(4) is of good moral character and satisfies the requirements of Rule 14-708;

11 ~~(a)~~(5) has successfully passed the MPRE and ~~the Bar Examination~~ either

13 (i) successfully passed the Bar Examination; or

14

15 (ii) is qualified for, and has completed the requirements of, the Alternate Path under
16 Rule 14-703A;

17 ~~(a)~~(6) has a proven record of ethical, civil and professional behavior; and

18 ~~(a)~~(7) complies with the provisions of Rule 14-716 concerning licensing and enrollment
19 fees.
